Integrated Authority File (GND) data service: Changes in MARC 21 format for authority data from 16 October 2018 (export release 2018.03)

Dear Sir or Madam,

We would like to draw your attention to export release 2018.03 relating to the MARC 21 format for authority data.

1. Schedule

1.1. Format Changes

The release planning¹ includes an external test phase. The field description and the test data are published at the beginning of this phase (see section 3). Over the next two weeks, an external test phase will be implemented to allow all data users to test the test data for import and the Online Standard Interface (ONS)² in relation to the signalised format changes.

For the 2018.03 release, the external test phase is:

9 - 20 July 2018

The changes will apply from:

2. Format changes

2.1. MARC field 040 (Cataloging source) (NR): Firsttime delivery of subfield \$c (Transcribing agency) (NR)

MARC field 040 (Cataloging source) (NR) now delivers the International Standard Identifier for Libraries and Related Organisations (ISIL)⁴ of the record creator in both subfield \$a (Original cataloging agency) (NR) and, for the first time, in subfield \$c (Transcribing agency). Subfield \$c must be completed for the purpose of importing GND data into the OCLC WorldCat⁵.

First indicator: # - undefined

2.2. MARC field 382 (Medium of Performance) (R): new subfields \$e (Number of ensembles of the same type) (R) and \$t (Total number of ensembles) (NR)

The above-mentioned subfields \$e and \$t are now delivered to facilitate mapping in MARC 21 of the changes in RDA 6.15 (Medium of Performance) in the RDA Toolkit⁸ Release August 2017.

2.3. New code in MARC field 042 (Authentication Code) (NR), subfield \$a (Authentication code) (R)

In order to identify protected GND records, the value "gndz" (GND protected record, protected from editing or updating) is now delivered in subfield \$a (Authentication code). The new code was announced on 1 December 2017. Codes are entered in compliance with the MARC Authentication Action Code List 10.

MARC field 042 (Authentication Code) (NR)

Subfield \$a (Authentication code) (R):

- | gnd1 GND authenticated by curation team of a library network [signifies that the record is part of the Integrated Authority File (GND Gemeinsame Normdatei (Deutsche Nationalbibliothek)) and that it was authenticated by a curation team of a library network.]
- | gnd2 GND authenticated by a local curation team [signifies that the record is part of the Integrated Authority File (GND -Gemeinsame Normdatei (Deutsche Nationalbibliothek)) and that it was authenticated by a local curation team.]
- | gnd3 GND authenticated by trained users [signifies that the record is part of the Integrated Authority File (GND -Gemeinsame Normdatei (Deutsche Nationalbibliothek)) and that it was authenticated by trained users.]
- gnd4 GND authenticated by untrained users [signifies that the record is part of the Integrated Authority File (GND Gemeinsame Normdatei (Deutsche Nationalbibliothek)) and that it was authenticated by untrained users.]
- | gnd5 GND authenticated by other non-librarian users [signifies that the record is part of the Integrated Authority File (GND -Gemeinsame Normdatei (Deutsche Nationalbibliothek)) and that it was authenticated by other non-librarian users.]
- | gnd6 GND legacy data, not authenticated [signifies that the record is part of the Integrated Authority File (GND -Gemeinsame Normdatei (Deutsche Nationalbibliothek)) and that it consists of legacy data not authenticated by a curation team.]
- gnd7 GND automatically generated record, not authenticated [signifies that the record is part of the Integrated Authority File (GND Gemeinsame Normdatei (Deutsche Nationalbibliothek)) and that it was not authenticated, but generated automatically.]
- | gndz GND protected record [signifies that the record is part of the Integrated Authority File (GND -Gemeinsame Normdatei (Deutsche Nationalbibliothek)) and that it it is protected from editing or updating.]
- Further values from the "MARC Authentication Action Code List" may be used 11.
